
Contest Regulations

§ 1 Organizer and subject matter of the contest.

1. The organizer of the contest is BELLER Sp. z o. o. with its registered office in Warsaw, 71 Mokotowska Street, registered in the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register kept by the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw in Warsaw, XII Business Department of the National Court Register under KRS no.: 0000853969, NIP: 7010993118, REGON: 386724575, share capital: PLN 5,000, hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer".
2. The subject of the competition is to create graphic designs of jewelry for the BELLER brand in RHINO 3D software in three competition categories:
 1. CAPSULE COLLECTION - concerning the creation of a coherent concept of a jewelry collection with a theme. The collection must include stiff bracelets, earrings, rings, necklaces or ear cuffs, pendants - a minimum of 18 - 25 products. Small stones (diamonds, sapphires or others) with ranges of 1.5x1.5 mm - 2x2 mm can be embedded in the jewelry. The decision on the use of individual elements and their combination is up to the Participant;
 2. YOUR WAY COLLECTION - concerning the creation of a coherent concept of jewelry collection with a theme of 18 - 25 products. The collection must include stiff bracelets, earrings, rings, necklaces or ear cuffs, pendants. Prevalence in the collection of rings and earrings. The range of stones should be within the parameters of 1.5x1.5mm to 6x6mm for round shape, for oval shapes and baguette in 7x5mm or 6x4mm formats. Cushion cut - 5x5mm or 6x6mm, while let the trillion be no larger than 7x7mm. It is up to the Participant to decide what stones he will choose (precious stones only), and into what combinations and variations he will combine them.
 3. YOUR DREAM PRODUCT BELLER - concerning the creation of a concept for a product that could enter as an accessory to a jewelry brand, such as a handbag, glasses, etc.. The organizer does not present any additional requirements here - one product or more. In this category, Participants are to present their point of view for individual products. It is possible to use both gold, silver, precious stones, including diamonds, and other materials necessary to make a product according to the Participants' idea.
3. All competition entries must be in accordance with the objectives of the respective competition category, both technically and realistically feasible, designed in such a way as to ensure their compliance with the principles of respect for bullion and precious stones. Stones must not be pitted for

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- setting. All competition entries must be consistent with the image of the BELLER brand, refer to a cross-section of existing products and represent an innovative approach to classic jewelry forms while maintaining an elegant form.
4. The purpose of the Contest is to select the Winners (one each) in each category of the Contest, to showcase the creativity of the Participants and, if the Winners agree, to enable them to further cooperate with the Organizer in the creation of new jewelry products.
 5. The founder of the prizes in all Contests is the Organizer.
 6. The contest is organized via the Internet, on the territory of the Republic of Poland.
 7. The Organizer allows for the possibility of submission of contest applications by persons with residence outside the territory of Poland. In such case, the Applicant is obliged to send a tax residency certificate along with the Contest application.
 8. The Organizer reserves the right not to award prizes to Participants who act contrary to the Regulations or who do not meet the requirements specified therein.
 9. The Organizer reserves the right, at any stage of the Contest, to exclude a Contest Participant who acts contrary to the Contest rules described in the Regulations or in a manner that violates generally applicable laws.
 10. The Organizer has the right to exclude the Participant from the Contest with immediate effect and refuse to award the Prize in case the Participant provided false or incomplete data required and necessary for the awarding of the Prize, moreover, if at any stage of the Contest it turns out that the submitted graphic design was not made by the Participant or was created with the participation of another entity. The above right shall also be vested in the Organizer if the Participant, in order to obtain a favorable result, uses devices or programs that make it possible to bypass the contest requirements, in particular by generating automatic responses or obtaining favorable time results.
 11. The Organizer retains the right to moderate and remove statements that are vulgar, offensive and/or violate the good name of the Organizer and promote entrepreneurs and products that compete with the Organizer's products, even after prior approval of the contest entry.
 12. The Organizer is not obliged to inform Participants of exclusion from the Contest.
 13. The Organizer informs that the Contest is not organized with the participation of, nor sponsored or supported by other entities.

§ 2 Participants of the Contest

1. A contest participant is a person who has sent a contest application to the Organizer within the time limit and under the conditions specified in these Regulations.
2. The Contest has an open, one-stage character.
3. Only natural persons of full legal age, not running a business, may participate in the Contest.
4. The Contest is dedicated to design students and for jewelry enthusiasts and lovers who have the knowledge, skills and tools necessary to perform the Contest task, and who would like to start their career in creating jewelry products.

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5. Employees of the Organizer and members of the Contest Committee, as well as members of their immediate families, may not participate in the Contest. The closest person is a spouse, ascendant, descendant, sibling, relative in the same line or degree, a person in an adoption relationship and his/her spouse, as well as a person in cohabitation.

§ 3 Rules of participation

1. The condition of participation in the Contest is:
 - a. sending the Contest application to the Organizer's e-mail address: design@beller.pl by 25.07.2023
 - b. The Contest application should contain the name, surname, e-mail address, telephone number and an indication of which Contest category the Contest application is for, as well as:
 - i. A presentation with moodboard, storytelling and renders (RHINO 3D software project screenshots and RHINO 3DM project sent WeTRANSFER to analyze the designs);
 - ii. Graphic designs with specifications of each element (size, height, width, perimeter, caste size) made in RHINO 3D software,
 - iii. a certificate of tax residency (concerning people with residence outside Poland).
2. The Organizer is entitled to extend the deadline for submission of contest entries by up to 14 days.
3. One Participant may submit several contest entries for several categories, with the proviso that a maximum of one contest entry may be submitted for one category.
4. Incomplete entries will not be considered. However, the Organizer reserves the right to call on the 4. Participant to complete or correct his/her application within the deadline specified by the Organizer.
5. All graphic designs must be made in RHINO 3D program.
6. The Organizer points out that after the Winners are selected, it may become necessary to make changes to the submitted designs in case of further cooperation with the Organizer.

§ 4 Rules and course of the Competition

1. Information about the Contest, in addition to its placement on the Organizer's website <https://www.beller.pl/pl/> , will be sent to universities selected by the Organizer to inform students interested in participating in the Contest.
2. The evaluation of the Competition works for each Competition category will be made by the Competition Committee (hereinafter referred to as the "Committee") consisting of 5 persons indicated by the Organizer. The decisions of the Commission are final and not subject to change.
3. In case of any doubts regarding the course of the Contest, the Commission shall be the deciding body.
4. The Commission will evaluate the works within the scope of each Competition category in terms of:
 - a. compliance with the theme of the Competition (1-10 points);
 - b. visual attractiveness, ingenuity, originality and creativity (1-10 points)
 - c. compliance with the requirements of the Regulations, including the technical feasibility of using finished jewelry products to make them,

taking into account the principles of respect for bullion and precious stones (1-10 points)

5. Announcement of the results of the Contest will be made within 14 days from the date of completion of the call referred to in §3 paragraph 1 letter a.
6. The Organizer reserves the right to extend the deadline for announcing the results of the Contest, of which it will notify the Participants.
7. Decisions of the Committee are final (no appeal from them).
8. The Organizer reserves the right not to select the Winners of the Contest in case none of the Contest works obtains the minimum number of points (50%), evaluated according to the criteria indicated in paragraph 4,

§ 5 Prizes and Winners

1. The Contest Committee will select one Winner in each contest category.
2. The Winner in each contest category is entitled to receive a financial prize (hereinafter: Prize) in the amount of PLN 8,000.
3. Prizes are not convertible to prizes in kind or services.
4. One Participant may win more than one prize if he/she has submitted a contest entry for more than one contest category.
5. In order to claim the Prize, the Winner is obliged to contact the Organizer (e-mail: design@beller.pl) within 3 working days from the date of results' announcement on <https://www.beller.pl/pl/> , in order to provide data necessary for the transfer of the Prize, including data necessary for fulfilling tax obligations, moreover, to sign an agreement on transfer of copyrights to the Contest work sent together with the Contest entry.
6. Lack of contact from the Winner within the timeframe specified in paragraph 5 shall mean the loss of the right to the Prize.
7. In addition to the Prize, the Contest Winners will also receive an additional cash prize equivalent to the amount of income tax on the value of the Prize, which will not be paid to the Winners. The Winners of the competition agree to transfer the additional cash prize as income tax due for payment by the Organizer to the competent tax authority.
8. The Organizer agrees to transfer the Prizes in each contest category within 30 days from the date the Winners provide all data necessary for its transfer and conclude an agreement on the transfer of copyrights to the contest work.
9. The Organizer is not responsible for the inability to transfer the Prize for reasons beyond its control, in particular:

a. providing incorrect personal data, bank account, competent tax office or, in the case of persons living abroad, failure to provide a tax residency certificate.

b. force majeure events within the meaning of the Civil Code Act.

10. In the event that, after the Winners are selected, it turns out that the Organizer was misled by the Winner, or in the event that the Participant's actions contrary

to the Regulations of the contest are revealed, the Organizer has the right not to transfer the Prize.

§ 6 Processing of personal data

1. Participation in the contest is tantamount to the Participant's consent to the inclusion of personal data, including name and surname in the place of publication of the announcement of the results of the contest and information on the awarding of the Prize.
2. The Participants' personal data will be processed in accordance with the provisions of the Act of August 29, 1997 on the protection of personal data and the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of April 27, 2016 on the protection of natural persons in relation to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation), hereinafter referred to as "RODO".
3. The administrator of the Participants' personal data is the Organizer.
4. The Participants' personal data will be processed exclusively for purposes related to the conduct of the Contest, including the issuance of the Prizes, the settlement of any tax liabilities related to the issuance of the Prizes, and the conclusion of an agreement with the Winners.
5. The scope of personal data processed by the Organizer includes first and last name, email address and telephone number, and in the case of Winners, PESEL number (if applicable) or passport number.
6. Provision of personal data is voluntary, but necessary in order to participate in the Contest, transfer the Prizes, fulfill tax obligations and conclude an agreement on the transfer of author's economic rights.
7. Your personal data is processed in accordance with Article 6.1.a (consent), Article 6.1.b RODO (processing is necessary for the execution of the agreement) and Article 6.1.c RODO (processing is necessary for the fulfillment of a legal obligation incumbent on the administrator, such as tax and other settlements under the law).
8. Your personal data may be shared with data recipients within the meaning of Article 4(9) RODO only within the limits and provisions of the law, e.g. with whom the administrator has signed data processing agreements on behalf of the administrator.
9. Personal data may be provided to authorized state authorities, legal protection bodies (Police, Prosecutor's Office, Court) or in connection with ongoing proceedings.
10. Your personal data will be stored in accordance with applicable laws, including the law on archiving.
11. Your personal data will not be subject to automated decision-making processes by the Administrator, including profiling.
12. Your personal data may be transferred to a third country in connection with the need to make tax settlements when the Winner resides outside the Polish border.
13. You have the right to access the content of your personal data and to rectify, erase or restrict its processing (if not restricted by the fulfillment of a legal

provision). You have the right to access the content of your personal data and to correct, delete or restrict its processing (if not restricted by law).

14. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority - the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection pursuant to Article 77 of the RODO (...any data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, (...) if he/she believes that the processing of personal data concerning him/her violates this Regulation) - Office for Personal Data Protection, Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw, tel. 22 531-03-00, www.uodo.gov.pl

§ 7 Copyright

1. The Contest Participant declares and guarantees that he/she will be entitled to the entirety of the copyrights to the submitted Contest work, especially to the projects in the form of final files for the Contest Committee's evaluation in RHINO format, moreover to the remaining materials, including graphics or photos, created in connection with the execution of the Contest task, which will meet the definition of a work within the meaning of the Act of 4.02.1994 on Copyright and Related Rights.
2. The Competition Participant declares that the copyrights to the Competition work can be transferred, in accordance with the provisions of the Law on Copyright and Related Rights in the manner specified in the Regulations, including not being encumbered by the rights of other persons.
3. The Contest participant is obliged to exercise the utmost care not to expose the Organizer to any damages or claims. In the event that such damages or claims arise as a consequence (directly and indirectly) of the Participant's actions or complicity, as well as the falsity (even partial) of his/her statements, the Participant shall be fully responsible for them. In the event of the occurrence of such damages, the Participant undertakes to indemnify the Organizer from any liability on this account and, upon a single request of the Organizer, to enter in its place in pending proceedings, discussions or negotiations. If such ascension proves impossible, the Participant is obliged to actively support the Organizer in protecting his/her rights and to pay all costs associated with such protection.
4. In order to receive the Prize, the winner of the competition is obliged to conclude an agreement transferring the author's economic rights to the competition work under the terms and conditions specified therein.
5. Refusal to conclude the agreement referred to in paragraph 4 by the Contest Winner is tantamount to waiving the Winner's right to the Prize. The Prize will be paid only if the agreement indicated in paragraph 4 is concluded.
6. The transfer of author's economic rights referred to in §7 shall be made in exchange for the right to obtain the Prize, without additional compensation.

§ 8 Final Provisions

1. The Organizer reserves the right to make changes to the Regulations if the changes are favorable to the Participants of the Contest and to extend the duration of the Contest. Each time the Organizer will announce the changes to the Regulations in the places of their publication.

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2. The Organizer reserves the right to terminate and/or shorten the duration of the Contest.
 3. Any disputes that may arise in connection with the performance of obligations under the Contest will be resolved by a court of jurisdiction in accordance with the provisions of the Code of Civil Procedure.
 4. The law applicable to the execution of the Contest shall be Polish law at all times.
 5. All information about the Contest Participants can obtain by contacting the Organizer at e-mail address: design@beller.pl
 6. The Regulations are available for review at the Organizer's office.
 7. Participant may resign from the Contest by sending an e-mail to - design@beller.pl with information about such resignation. Resignation in the case of the winner of the Contest causes the loss of the right to the awarded Prize, which then remains at the exclusive disposal of the Organizer.
 8. The Organizer is not responsible for the functioning of the Internet network through which Participants send Contest entries, as well as through which the Organizer contacts the Participant.
 9. The Organizer is not responsible for Contest entries lost or misplaced on the Internet, content sent in the entries, individual computer settings and the way they are configured.
 10. The Organizer has the right to cancel the Contest at any time without giving any reason.
